Twin Cities Mobile Market Brings Affordable Grocery Store on Wheels to PHA Sites

The Saint Paul Public Housing Agency (PHA) is excited to partner with the Amherst H. Wilder Foundation to bring the Twin Cities Mobile Market, a grocery store on wheels, to four public housing sites (Valley Hi-Rise, McDonough Homes, Mt. Airy Homes, and Iowa Hi-Rise). Residents at these four sites will now have access to fresh and affordable groceries without having to travel far. Residents can request for certain food items if they do not see them in the Mobile Market. The Twin Cities Mobile Market will try to accommodate the requests as long as the requested items are healthy.

The Twin Cities Mobile Market stops at 17 locations in Saint Paul five days a week and offers a wide variety of food such as fruits, vegetables, meats, dairy products and dry goods. The Twin Cities Mobile Market plans to operate year round and will offer as many local and in-season fruits and vegetables as possible.
